Welcome from Amanda Bousaki -Designated Clinical Officer (DCO) for special educational needs and disability



I would like to introduce myself to you as Amanda Bousaki, the Designated Clinical Officer for special educational needs and disability – the DCO for short.

The <u>Milton Keynes SEND Local Offer</u> provides further information about the role of the DCO.

We have had a busy few months in Health:

Many health services attended the **SEND Information Day** in February with staff available to talk through their service offer and answer any questions that people had. This popular annual event is a great opportunity to learn about what services are available in MK - it's like a live Local Offer (LO)! Speaking of the <u>Local Offer</u>, we have been working hard with the team at the Local Authority and a group of parents to redesign the look and content of our new website to make sure information is more accessible and visually easier on the eye. More info about that below.

We have various projects that are being co-produced; one of them being our BLMK wide **Autism and ADHD pathways** and support. This is the result of your feedback to us about what we can be doing better. We want to make sure that children, young people and parents get the support they need, when they need it. There is also a group of parents and professionals involved in making this happen in MK.

CAMHS have launched their **Young Persons forum** in the past couple of weeks – get involved in helping them make services better for you!

Parents have also been asking for support to understand the needs of their child with ADHD – staff are currently being trained to provide a **parent programme** on this.

You told us that you were worried and anxious about your young person transitioning to adult services. We now have a **Transitions Nurse** post in CAMHS and another for those young people who have complex health needs.

Our **hospital in-patient** service now has a complex needs pathway Nurse who is dedicated to supporting young people and parents during their stay in hospital and ensuring a smooth discharge home with services in place.

Health's Occupational Therapy Professional Lead delivered a really informative 1.5 hr presentation on **Sensory Needs** as part of CNWL's Year of the Child. This is available on the <u>Local Offer</u>. It really gives a great insight into sensory needs and how these affect anxiety levels.


Local Offer update

The annual Milton Keynes SEND information day took place on Saturday 4th February at The Ridgeway Centre.



This annual event is coproduced by PACA MK and MK SENDIAS. It was great to meet so many of you face to face again for our first full event since the pandemic.

Approximately 300 parents, children, young people and professionals attended and we would like to thank everyone who helped to make the event such a successful day.

There were 30 information stands representing health, education and the voluntary sector. Information about all the organisations that attended can still be accessed via our website.

The event was opened by the Mayor of Milton Keynes Cllr Amanda Marlow followed by an introduction from Mac Heath, Director of Children's Services. Shout service - text Reflect

Please find an update regarding the launch of the new Shout Reflect text messaging service for young people in Bedford Borough, Central Bedfordshire, Luton and Milton Keynes

- A new text messaging service has been launched:
- Young people can text reflect to 85258 if they need advice or help. Reflect is free and does not show up on phone bills
- The service is confidential and available 24/7

The Shout Reflect service is specifically for young people across Bedfordshire, Luton and Milton Keynes. The service is delivered in partnership with Shout.

It is delivered by trained volunteers and clinicians who are available around the clock to listen and support anyone who is feeling anxious, lonely, overwhelmed or

not quite themselves. It is part of the wider network of Shout services across the UK.
