







Improving Annual Reviews

Recently, our SEND Team hosted a "Courageous Conversation" session, bringing together representatives from local authorities across the South East region, schools, and the Parent and Carer Alliance MK (PACAMK) to explore the Annual Review process for children and young people with Education, Health and Care Plans (EHCPs).

This session was a structured, open, and honest discussion, held as part of our ongoing commitment to strengthening SEND partnerships. It provided an opportunity to reflect on how the current Annual Review process captures the full picture of a child's needs across education, health, and social care and to consider how it might evolve to better recognise and celebrate each child's progress and achievements.

This was a positive and productive session, offering space for honest reflection, peer challenge, and shared learning. It supported our preparation for future engagement and inspections and helped us identify practical ways to strengthen outcomes for children and young people with SEND.

We'll continue working closely with families and professionals to build on this momentum and make the Annual Review process more inclusive, transparent, and effective.

The Mental Health Support Teams (MHST's)

<u>The Mental Health Support Teams</u> work with local schools to help improve wellbeing. They provide early support for children and young people who may be experiencing some early concerns with their mental health.

The Team work across Milton Keynes in primary and secondary schools and the Bletchley campus of MK College offering early, evidence-based interventions for mild to moderate mental health difficulties.
