SEND Service

You'd have contact with this service if your child is going through an EHC needs assessment; has an EHCP; or accesses respite or an EOTAS package.

Short breaks and Furze House
Delivery of respite activities, and overnight stays.

Educational Psychology
Support for schools and children and young people via psychological theories and approaches that promote positive outcomes.

Education, health and care assessments and plans
Coordination of statutory processes relating to EHC assessments and plans, including annual reviews, phase transfer and tribunal processes.

EHC Education Delivery Team
Delivery of education for children and young people with an EHCP who are not accessing school for a range of reasons.

Education Outcomes Service

This service primarily works with schools and settings in the local area, supporting high quality inclusive practice.

School improvement and support services
Delivery of traded services relating to whole school improvement for early years and statutory school age; and support for governing bodies

Schools & Settings Inclusion Support
Support for schools in identifying SEND and meeting need early via the graduated response to SEND, aimed primarily at those who do not have an EHC plan.

Support to improve outcomes for specific vulnerable groups
Delivering responsibilities to children who are looked after or have a social worker via our Virtual School, and support for improving outcomes for children from the global majority via our EMA network; and section 19 provision for children without an EHC plan who are unable to attend a school or setting.
